## **AVOCATIONS**

After my aviation and flying years, and as advertising Account Executive for Yamaha motorcycles and Western Region Manager for Harley Davidson, I engaged in what I consider the greatest sports avocation of my life *-- Motorcycle Racing!* 

In the 1970's, I was very active in the Southern California motocross circuit, and additionally competed in all SoCal Grand Prix events. As an amateur expert, I also twice finished the famed 180-mile *Barstow to Vegas* desert race; and took 1st Place Amateur Expert in the 100 mile, AC Delco World Championship at Riverside International Raceway. Legendary racer and record holder Mickey Thompson conceived this major Delco sponsored event, with the objective of bringing long distance Baja and desert racing to a ten mile, closed course, spectator event.

I later became an avid street rider eventually covering thousands of miles. In 1978, I rode across the United States to commemorate the Seventy-Fifth Anniversary of Harley Davidson. I was then General Manager, Motorcycle Sales. Sixteen executives started from different locations around the nation, with my ride beginning in San Francisco, CA, and ending back in Milwaukee, WI. Part of the trip was a rendezvous of all participants at Louisville Downs, where we circled the track and had a wonderful banquet. Every year when I see the famous Kentucky Derby, I recall my pass around that track on my 1340 cc Harley Davidson Wide Glide!

My longest interest has been the Velikovskian interdisciplinary synthesis of physical science and mind. Immanuel Velikovsky, MD was a psychiatrist who had studied under Freud, and later collaborated with Einstein. On July 25, 1977, I had the opportunity to spend an afternoon with this great polymath at his home in New Jersey.

Philosophy, Psychoanalysis and Depth Psychology then became my primary focus, with in-depth study of the entire collected works of Friedrich Nietzsche, Sigmund Freud, and Carl Jung. In the 1980s, this included a broader study of psychology and philosophy with a retained tutor from Vanderbilt University. In 1990, while temporarily living in Chicago, I attended the C. G. Jung Institute as a night student and received a *Certificate of Achievement* in Jungian psychology.
