1. Having been discharged from the U. S. Marine Corps Reserve on 31 July 1958, at Headquarters, 1st Marine Corps Reserve and Recruitment District, and having enlisted in the U. S. Marine Corps this date for a period of four (4) years, you are transferred effective this date. Pursuant to authority contained in references (a) and (b), you will proceed to Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, California, reporting upon arrival to the Commanding General, for temporary additional duty in connection with processing and further transfer with the first available replacement battalion for duty as a replacement.
2. You have elected to perform the travel in connection with these orders via privately owned conveyance. You are authorized thirteen days travel time, and ten days delay enroute, to count as leave, and will report to your new duty station not later than 2400, 24 August 1958.
3. You will maintain the proper decorum at all times while enroute to your new duty station.
4. Your staff returns will be forwarded by mail to the commanding General, Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, California.
